## ***CONCEPT NOTE***

Intellectual Property (IP) in the form of know-how, creativity, information and inventiveness is rapidly substituting the traditional forms of property. Intellectual Property Rights (IPRs) protection provides incentive to protect the same, thereby, fostering innovation and scientific temper. By persuading and protecting the incentives to innovate, IPRs significantly influence the national economy. Thus, fortification of IPRs is a crucial component of financial policy for every country. However, the evolution of the IPRs has taken place in different countries as per the country specific needs. Responding to the need of the hour and conforming to its international obligations arising out of various treaties and conventions, India has come up with a comprehensive legal regime to protect intellectual property. IPR regime in India comprises of strong IPR laws but, there are pertinent issues which are yet to be addressed like IP sensitization, strengthening the legal regime so as to foster the international trust, adjudication of IP matters etc. Moreover, there appears a significant gap between the theory and practice of IPRs.

With this view to craft consciousness on the importance of different forms of IPRs and to deliberate upon the issues critical to IPRs, KLE Society's Law College, Bengaluru is organizing a Two-Day National Workshop on Intellectual Property Rights: A Practitioner's Approach.
